➤ Objective TAF (& TAP RU/IM) Revision

- Cycle started in October 2018
- Intermediate publication in March 2021
- ERA draft Recommendation in January 2022
- 2nd ERA draft Recommendation in January 2024
- Vote by RISC in June 2024

- Fine-tuning/Updating the data model
- Fine-tuning/Updating the processes

➤ European legislation and initiatives for digitalization and mobility

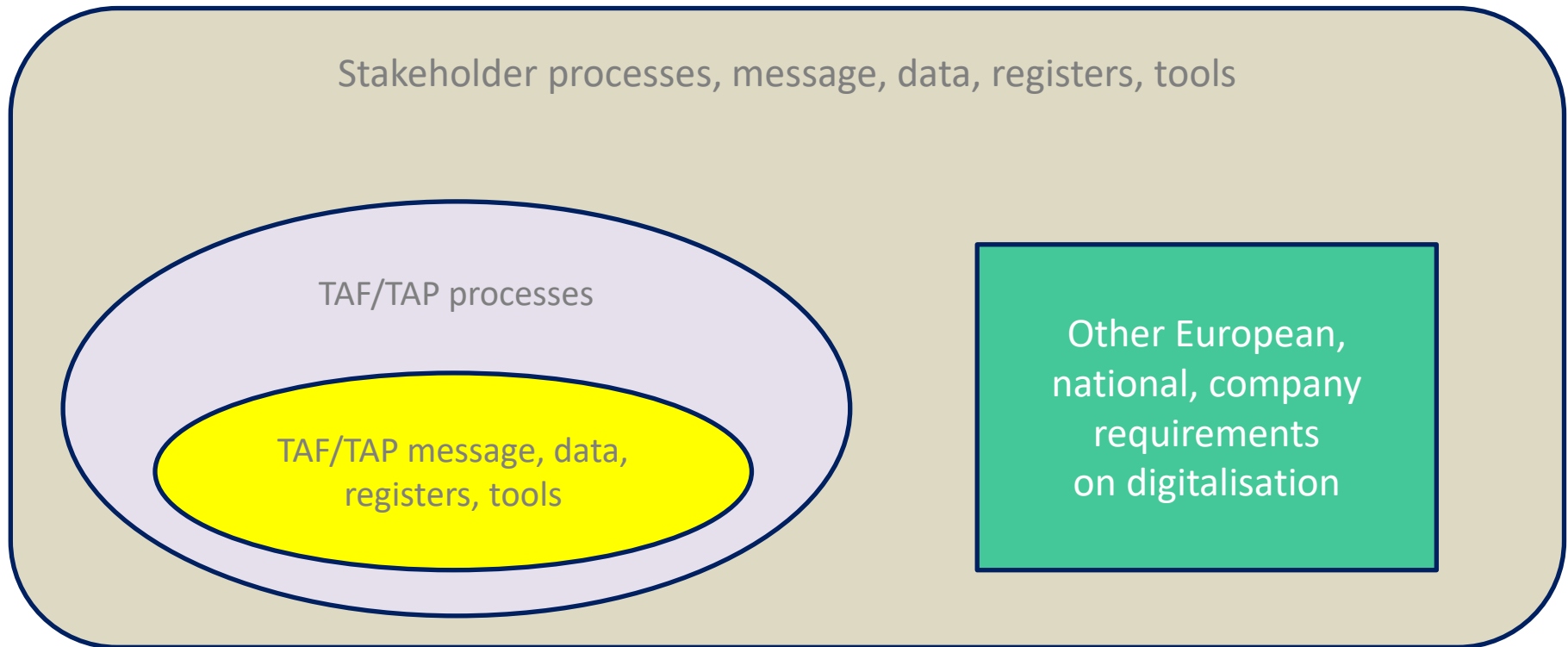
- Green Deal (presented in December 2019)

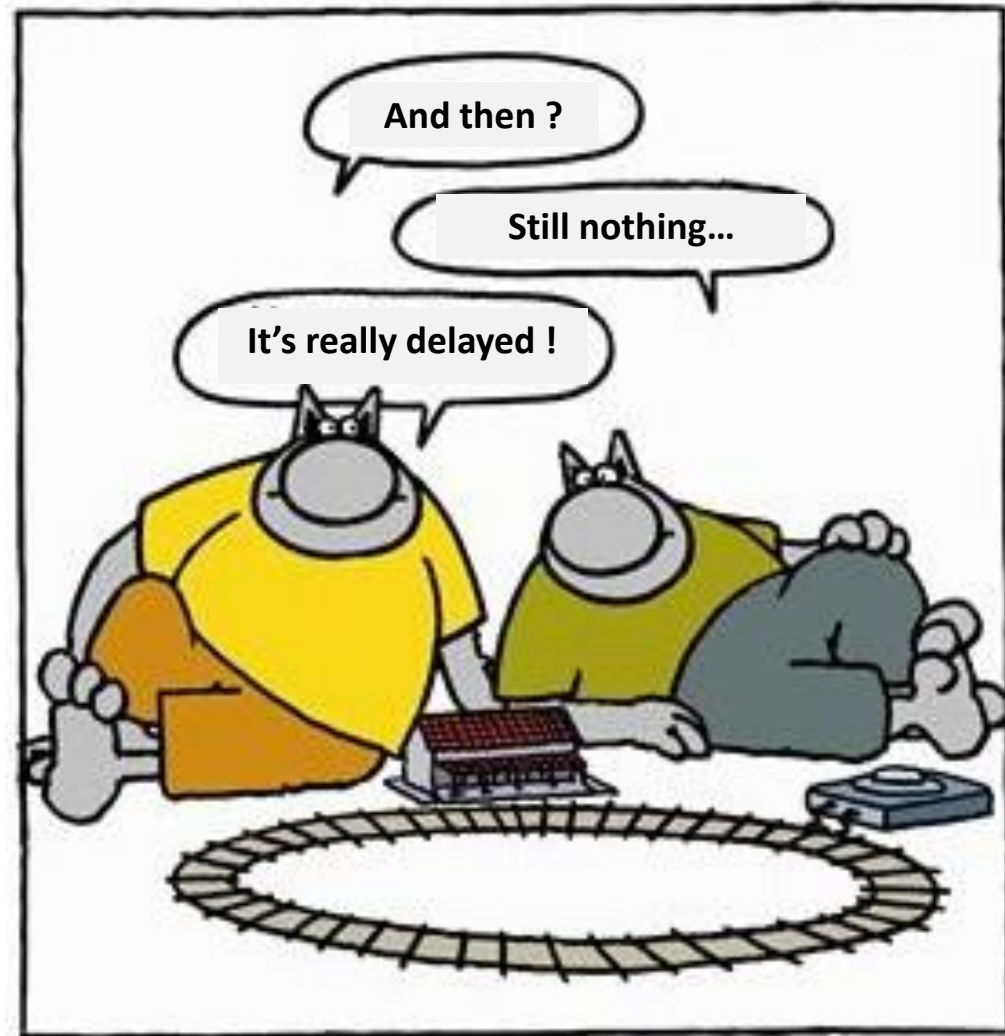
