

Invitation to participate in the 2024 TAF-TAP RU/IM Reporting Session

Dear colleagues,

in accordance with the regulations on the Technical Specifications for Interoperability relating to the telematics applications (TAF and TAP TSIs), the European Commission has given the mandate to the European Union Agency for Railways (ERA) to assess its implementation across Europe. For RU/IM communication, ERA has established the 'TAF TSI Implementation Cooperation Group (ICG)'.

The Telematics Joint Sector Group (JSG) is the key central driver of the RU-IM implementation supported by fourteen associations. The JSG uses the EUSurvey tool, to collate the TAF and TAP TSI implementation reports related to RU-IM functions from the companies with the following benefits:

- report structure agreed between ERA and JSG
- harmonized roadmap towards the upcoming ERA ICG meeting
- preliminary check of results before submission to ERA

For the upcoming reporting period 2024 the Infrastructure Managers (IMs), the Freight and Passenger Railway Undertaking (RUs) and the Wagon Keepers (WKs) are asked to provide their implementation status reports. CER offers a dedicated page at the [JSG website](#) for further information.

With this letter, the JSG invites all members of its stakeholders to answer the questionnaire in the EUSurvey Tool to meet the TAF/TAP TSI obligations.
